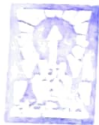


## **REPORT ON DISTRICT LEVEL SCIENCE QUIZ COMPETITION**

The District Level Science Quiz Competition was held on 18th October, 2022 in the RKMV College, Shimla. The competition was organized by the Red Ribbon Club of the State to encourage students to develop an interest in Science and enhance their knowledge about it. All the Colleges in the State were invited to participate in this event. A total of 25 teams participated in this competition which included 50 students from different colleges. The first round of the quiz competition was a written test with 61 questions. The participants had to answer questions based on topics like HIV AIDS, Blood safety /Blood Transfusion, STIs, COVID 19, Tuberculosis, Drug abuse, Mental health, Adolescent and Reproductive health and Sexual health, Youth issues, Diet and nutrition and Human anatomy. Two students of our college, Nidhi Sharma and Priyanka Sharma of B.Sc. II and III year respectively represented our college. The students were accompanied by Prof. Shivani Khatri, Associate Professor Department of English. Students participated in the first round with great enthusiasm. The result of first round was declared within an hour. Unfortunately our students could not qualify the first round but it was a matter of great pride that amongst 25 colleges our college came 5<sup>th</sup> in position and only four teams qualified for the next round. Our College students were awarded certificates for their participation in the quiz competition. It was a great learning experience and exposure to our students.
