7. Our focus is on the students' learning and providing efficient services when they need help.
8. We offer courses and training that are needed, and a variety of study programs at different levels with enough flexibility.
9. We use the assessment and grading system set by the University to evaluate our students fairly.
10. We keep track of students' progress and give feedback when needed.
11. Extra classes are arranged for students who need more help.
12. We have a mechanism for students to give feedback.
