## Annual Report (2023-24)



The college was founded in 1998 as a co-educational institution situated in Theog, Shimla District, Himachal Pradesh. The college mostly caters to the rural populace residing in and around Theog and offers programs in BA, B.Sc., and B.Com. The aggregate number of students enrolled in diverse fields and programs is 1086. The institution is a blessing, particularly for female students, who would otherwise might have to commute 25 kms to the main city of Shimla. The grand exterior of the current building and its associated infrastructure were constructed in 2006. The college possesses an adequate number of classrooms, laboratories, a well-supplied library, a spacious ground, a conference hall, and other necessary infrastructure. The college is accredited 'B' by NAAC. It is one among the 21 उत्कृष्ट महाविद्यालय declared by the Government of Himachal Pradesh.

The PTA body is always very supportive towards the welfare of the students, the progress and development of the college. It lends a helping hand in every endeavour of the college. Dr Mohinder Rathour, Secretary (PTA), has been very effective in establishing a healthy relationship between the parents and the students.

## NCC

The NCC unit of the college, comprising 45 registered cadets (17 boys, 28 girls), is playing a predominant role in lighting the flame of unity, discipline and nationalism among the students. Under the leadership of Prof Chandresh Kumar, NCC Caretaker Officer, the following activities were organized:

- On 5 May 2023, the '*Rank Ceremony*' was organized by 7 HP (I) Coy NCC Shimla in which rank holders were appointed for all the colleges. The rank holders were selected on the basis of their knowledge, practice, skills and interview.

- On 20 May 2023, the NCC cadets organized a debate competition as mandated by SSCD on the topic 'Plastic Free India'.
- On 17 June 2023, the NCC cadets participated in an *awareness program* on '*Water Conservation and Rainwater Harvesting*.'
- On 18 June 2023, the NCC cadets participated in a campaign against '*drug abuse'* in a program organized by the *Himachal Pradesh State Legal Services Authority* and inaugurated by Shri Tarlok Singh Chauhan, Honourable Justice, HP High Court.
- On 21 June 2023, the NCC cadets celebrated the '*International Yoga Day*' with the themes '*Har Aangan Yoga*' and '*Yoga for Vasudhaiv Kutumbakam*.'
- On 9 August 2023, a 'tree-plantation drive' was organized by the NCC cadets after cleaning the college premises.
- On 15 August 2023, the NCC cadets participated in the *Independence Day Parade* held at The Ridge, Shimla under the banner of 7 HP (I) Coy NCC, Shimla. The female wing of the NCC was led by Sergeant Reena Sharma of Govt. College Theog, which was a moment of immense pride for the institution.
- On 5 September 2023, the NCC cadets were instrumental in the successful conduct of Teachers' Day celebrations in the college.
- On 6 September 2023, the exercise of enrolment of new students was undertaken under the supervision of PI Staff CHM Vipul (1GR) and Havildar Lepcha (1GR) of 7 HP (I) Coy NCC Shimla. 15 students of the college successfully qualified for the test.
- On 19 September 2023, six NCC cadets participated in an *Inter-college Shooting Competition* where they competed in various disciplines such as air-rifle and pistol.
- On 1 October 2023, the NCC cadets participated in a mega-cleanliness drive with the overarching theme '*Ek Tareekh, Ek Ghanta, Ek Saath*', also known as '*Swachhta hi Seva*', to pay homage to Mahatma Gandhi on his birth anniversary.
- On 2 October 2023, the NCC cadets participated in a blood donation camp organized by SARVODAYA.
- On 6 and 7 October 2023, the NCC cadets were instrumental in the successful conduct of *HP University Inter-College Basketball Championship* in the college. They performed several duties such as managing several counters like registration and refreshment. Women cadets represented GC Theog in the competition and performed well in all their rounds.



- From 21 October to 1 November 2023, NCC cadet Ankit Sharma participated in the '*Ek Bharat, Shreshth Bharat*' (EBSB-1) held at Secunderabad, Telangana. EBSB is an initiative to promote cultural exchange and national integration between different states and UTs of India. The teams of which Cadet Ankit Sharma was a part won Gold medals in Cultural Program, Tug-of-war and Kho-Kho.
- From 25 October to 5 November 2023, NCC Under Officer (UO) Avnish and Cadet Saurabh Thakur took part in the 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of '*Ek Bharat, Shreshth Bharat*' (EBSB-2), organized by the Ambala group (PHHP & CDTE) at Ropar and won Gold Medals in Volleyball (SD) and Relay Race (JD) as part of a team.

#### NSS

The *NSS* plays an important role in the overall personality development of the students and in inculcating many qualities like leadership and discipline in them. The college NSS unit, comprising of 170 volunteers, is helmed by Dr Kalpana Sharma and Dr Rajesh Kumar, Assistant Professor(s) of Music (I) & Geography, respectively. The unit renders its services in all spheres of the college. During the academic session, the main activities of the unit were as follows:

- On 3 August 2023, the NSS volunteers along with their Program Officers (POs), planted saplings in the botanical garden/glass house.
- From 9 to 15 August 2023, the NSS volunteers organized many activities such as '*Vasudha Vandan*', '*Veeron ka Vandan*,' and a tree-plantation drive in the adopted Ward No. 1 of MC Theog under the overarching theme of '*Meri Mati Mera Desh*.'
- On 16 September 2023, the NSS volunteers celebrated '*World Ozone Day*' in collaboration with the Department of Geography.
- On 23 September 2023, the NSS volunteers celebrated "*NSS Day*" with much fanfare and organized many cultural activities.
- From 15 September to 15 October 2023, under the 'Swachhta hi Seva' campaign, a thorough cleanliness drive (both on and off campus) was organized.
- On October 1, 2023, the *NSS* unit of the college joined the nationwide campaign led by the Honourable Prime Minister to commemorate Mahatma Gandhi's birthday. As part of this campaign, the volunteers enthusiastically participated in the "*Ek Tarikh, Ek Ghanta*" events, volunteering for one-hour social service through a campus cleanliness drive.
- For the HPU Inter-college Basketball Championship (W) event hosted by the college, the NSS volunteers organized a one-day camp to undertake a cleanliness drive on October 4, 2023. The volunteers cleaned classrooms, desks, chairs, windowpanes, floors and the entire campus under the Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan Fortnight. Around 80 volunteers participated in the camp enthusiastically.
- The NSS volunteers organized a program under the theme "Meri Mati, Mera Desh" on 12 October 2023. The motto was "Mitti ko Naman, Veeron ka Vandan." An 'Amrit Kalash' yatra was undertaken after undertaking an oath pledging allegiance to work for the welfare of the country. Under this initiative, the NSS volunteers actively participated in collecting soil and rice from different homes. The collected grains were kept in the 'Amrit Kalash' (sacred vessel). This vessel was symbolic of India's unity and diverse cultural heritage and deep respect for the motherland. "Praan Pledge" was administered to all the volunteers by both the program officers. The pledge exhorted the students to fulfill their duties and responsibilities



towards the nation, taking pride in the promotion and preservation of India's rich cultural heritage and striving for the country's unity.

- On 31 October 2023, the NSS volunteers celebrated '*Khadi for Nation*' and '*Khadi for Fashion*' under the aegis of *Atma Nirbahar Bharat*.
- The NSS volunteers celebrated the Communal Harmony Flag Day as a part of the Communal Harmony Week celebrations from 19 to 25 November 2023. The students conveyed the message of communal harmony and brotherhood among the fellow students to promote unity in diversity. The students visited the main market, bus stand area, the Municipal Council, local Police Station, Civil Hospital, IPH & PWD departments and other government offices such as Excise & Taxation and pinned up flags to the staff members.
- The NSS unit of the college organized its "Annual Seven-days Special Camp" from 13 to 19 February 2024. The overarching theme of the camp was "Green India, Clean India."

#### **Road Safety Club**

The *Road Safety Club* of the college organized activities such as Quiz, power-point presentation, postermaking, collage making and slogan writing to sensitize the students regarding safe road behaviour and the importance of being a 'Good Samaritan' on 29 November 2023. On 9 December 2023, the *Road Safety Club* of the college, in collaboration with the '*Anti-Drugs & Cyber Crime Cell*' and the *NSS* unit organized an awareness program for the students. The two main resource persons for the day were Dr Baburam, Senior Physician, IGMC Shimla and Shri Kulbir Singh, SHO, Police Station, Theog. Other highlights of the program were several performances by the Department of Music including mime, skit and declamation.

#### **Rovers & Rangers**

Under the leadership of Dr Saroj Devi Negi and Prof Mrityunjay Sharma, the following activities were organised:

- The R&R unit celebrated World Scouting Sunrise Day & World Scarf Day on August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023. On this occasion poster making and slogan writing competitions were organised and unit members actively participated in these competitions. The students went to the nearby public places and wore their scout/guide scarf to make the "Spirit of Scouting/Guiding" visible. These events create a sense of responsibility among the unit members and boost their confidence level to visit the public places and spread awareness among the people regarding different issues of society and development.
- On 10 August 2023, a tree-plantation drive was organized in the college premises near the temple complex. This event was a collaboration with the Department of Public Administration and other clubs and societies of the college.

- "Communal Harmony Week" was celebrated by Rovers and Rangers Unit in collaboration with the NSS and



NCC units of the college from 19 to 25November 2023.

- On 21 November, the unit members, led by Ranger leader visited the Sub Divisional Magistrate (SDM) office Theog, and had an interactive session with the SDM Mr. Mukesh Sharma. He administered a pledge to the students regarding abstaining from drug abuse and also recorded a message so that it could be shared with all the students of the college and was later sent to the *The Bharat Scouts and Guides* Himachal Pradesh headquarters under the project *Nishchaya*. The objective of this visit was to include civil servants in social awareness initiatives.
- Four Rangers Prajal, Shalini Verma, Ambika (B.A. 2<sup>nd</sup> year) and Shivashni (B.A. 1<sup>st</sup> year) participated in the State *Level Republic Day Parade 2024 Selection Camp for Rangers (pre-RDC 2024) which was* organised by *The Bharat Scouts and Guides* Himachal Pradesh State Headquarters, and held at STC, Rewalsar, Distt. Mandi H.P. w.e.f. 24<sup>th</sup> Nov. to 28<sup>th</sup> Nov. 2023. In this camp, two students Prajal Sharma and Shalini Verma got selected for *Republic Day Parade Celebration 2024*.
- Rovers Sahil and Aman of B.A. 2<sup>nd</sup> year participated in the *State Level Republic Day Parade 2024 selection camp for Rovers* (pre-RDC-2024) at Rewalsar, Distt. Mandi, H.P. from 28<sup>th</sup> November to 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2023.
- In the month of November 2023, six Rangers, Samiksha, Prajal Sharma, Payal of B.A. 2<sup>nd</sup> year; Kajal, Sakshi and Shivashni of B.A. 1<sup>st</sup> year and three Rovers Rahul B.A.3<sup>rd</sup> year, Aman and Sahil of B.A. 2 registered themselves for *Yuva Apada Mitra Scheme* (YAMS) of *National Disaster Management Authority* (NDMA), Ministry of Home Affairs Govt. of India. The YAMS project aims at training 50,000 Disaster Management volunteers from Bharat Scouts & Guides in the 350 most disaster-prone districts of the country.

#### Women Cell

Under the dynamic leadership of Dr Nidhi Dhatwalia, Assistant Professor of Zoology, the following activities were organized by the Women Cell of the college:

- On 5<sup>th</sup> August, the Women Cell of the college organized a talk for the female students of the college to celebrate 'World Breast Feeding Week.' The celebration of the week extended from August 1 to 7, 2023. Dr Isha Chauhan, Gynecologist, Civil Hospital, Theog and Ms Rita Thakur, Counsellor for Adolescent Health at Nayi Disha Kendra (NDK) were the Resource Persons. Dr Chauhan dealt in detail on the theme of World Breast Feeding Week set by the World Alliance for Breast Feeding Action (WABA) for the current year, which was, "Let's make breastfeeding and work, work,"
- On 8<sup>th</sup> August, the *Women Cell* of the college organized a talk on "*Gender Sensitization*." Dr Anuja Sharma, Associate Professor of English (Retd.), St. Bede's College, was the Resource Person. She talked in detail about the strategies and initiatives that can be adopted to create an inclusive environment at workplaces. She also emphasized the roles, rights, and responsibilities of different genders. A short film too was shown to the students.
- On 31<sup>st</sup> October, a "*Mehendi*" competition was organized by the Women Cell Theog to enhance creativity and unleash the hidden talent of the students. Through this competition, the students got an opportunity to display their innate artistic potential. Students from 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year participated in this competition and expressed their ideas through beautiful designs.
- On 7<sup>th</sup> March, the Women Cell celebrated "International Women's Day" with a lot of enthusiasm under the overall theme "Invest in women, Accelerate progress". Various activities emphasizing on women empowerment were organized on this day. Students presented a group song, poetry, and gave speeches on women empowerment. Students also presented a beautiful presentation about strong and celebrated women of India.



## **Career Counselling & Placement Cell (CCPC)**

Under the able leadership of Dr Anita Rathour, Associate Professor of Sociology, the *Career Counselling & Placement Cell* of the college organised the following activities during the current academic session:

- On 4<sup>th</sup> August 2023, a career counselling session was organized for the students of B.A., B.Sc. & B.com. Final year. The Resource Persons were Ms. Seema Gupta, District Employment Officer, Shimla, and Ms. Aarti Thakur from *Himachal Pradesh Kaushal Vikas Nigam* (HP-KVN). They apprised the students about the government's different programs and initiatives.
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- On 9<sup>th</sup> August 2023, a career counselling session for B.Sc. final year students was organised in collaboration with the Department of Chemistry. The students learned about the numerous renowned institutions and were encouraged to pursue higher education in them.
- On 14<sup>th</sup> October 2023, an event on 'Future Business Sharks 2.0' was organised in collaboration with the Department of Commerce. The event kindled the spirit of entrepreneurship and innovation among the students.
- On 27<sup>th</sup> August 2023, in collaboration with the *Himachal Pradesh Kaushal Vikas Nigam* (HP-KVN), a workshop to raise awareness about employment opportunities was organised. Shri Jayant Sharma was the Resource Person. He delved in great detail on the professional paths available in the hospitality and tourism industries.
- On 5<sup>th</sup> December 2023, an event proposed by the Central Government on Hotel management and Food production was organised. Ms. Anchal from the tourism Industry was the Resource Person who promoted 'Yuva Tourism' and emphasised on waste management.
- On 21<sup>st</sup> February 2024, a job fair was organized for all the final-year college students across all the disciplines. Our students were shortlisted for the second round of recruitment by the Chandigarh-based business organisation "jobcoach.in." After graduating in June or July, the selected candidates will join their places of posting.
- A one-week "*Skill Enhancement Workshop*" was organized from 21<sup>st</sup> February 2024 to 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2024. The primary objective of the session was to effectively utilise our students' abilities in order to combat the various obstacles they encounter in the cut-throat world of everyday living.

## **House Examination**

Under the able leadership of Dr Yesh Desh Dulta, Controller of House Examination(s), a total of 1086 students appeared for the mid-term examination in 8 papers each across all the three years of BA/B.Sc. and B. Com. The exams were conducted w.e.f. 13 to 23 December 2023. Re-tests were conducted w.e.f. 19 to 26 February 2024 for the students who could not appear due to any genuine reason and for those who failed to pass in their respective subjects.

## Library

The college has a well-stocked library with 5101 books stacked in about 30 cupboards. The seating capacity of the library is 45 and it subscribes to about 8 newspapers in English and Hindi apart from 6 magazines for the students. The college offers a subscription to N-List (National Library and Information Services Information for Scholarly Content) to all its staff and students. A total of 746 students benefitted from the library infrastructure in the current academic year.



## **Red-Ribbon Club**

Under the able leadership of Dr Nidhi Dhatwalia, Assistant Professor of Zoology, the *Red Ribbon Club* of the college organized the following activities:

- The *Red Ribbon Club*, in collaboration with the Departments of *Botany & Zoology* organized a 'tree plantation drive' in the surrounding areas of the college on 10<sup>th</sup> August 2023. Around 50 saplings of 'Devdaar' were planted.
- The students of the *Red Ribbon Club* participated in an *AIDS Awareness Training Program* at RKMV Shimla on 20 November 2023. The training was designed and implemented with the primary objective of educating students about the transmission, prevention and stigma associated with HIV/AIDS and empower the students to make informed decisions regarding their health.


