Feedback Analysis and Action Taken on Feedback (2024-25)

Student Satisfaction Report (Curricular Aspects 2024–25)

The student feedback collected for the academic session 2024–25 reflects a generally positive level of satisfaction with the curricular aspects of the college. The responses highlight that a vast majority of students find the curriculum relevant, up-to-date, and effectively delivered by the faculty.

Curriculum & Syllabi

Most students rated the curriculum as Good to Excellent, indicating that the course content aligns well with academic and career expectations. A small number of students expressed that improvement is possible, suggesting periodic revisions could enhance curriculum relevance.

Syllabus Coverage

Students reported high satisfaction with syllabus coverage in classes. Responses show that teachers are consistent in completing the planned academic content. A few students mentioned “Fair” coverage, suggesting the need for slightly better pacing in some subjects.

Course Delivery

The feedback shows that teaching methods are perceived as effective and engaging. Students appreciated the use of structured lesson plans, regular interaction, and clarity of explanations. However, a small portion of students felt that more interactive or practical approaches could further improve engagement.

Faculty Preparedness & Communication Clarity

A significant majority rated the faculty as well-prepared and able to communicate concepts clearly. This reflects strong pedagogical practices and commitment from faculty members.

Value Addition to Knowledge & Skills

Students acknowledged that the courses contribute positively to their overall learning, skill development, and conceptual understanding. The responses indicate satisfaction with the academic rigor and relevance of subjects.

Overall Learning Experience

Overall, students conveyed a positive and satisfactory learning experience. Most rated it as Good to Excellent, suggesting that the teaching-learning environment of the college is student-friendly, academically oriented, and conducive to holistic development.

Suggestions

Some students encouraged the institution to continue existing best practices, especially appreciating the faculty’s dedication and classroom environment.

Conclusion

The feedback indicates strong student satisfaction, particularly in areas of curriculum relevance, teaching quality, syllabus coverage, and faculty engagement.

20.	Organize more workshops for student learning	Departments are conducting more workshops and hands-on sessions




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21.	Regular English learning and communication skill classes	English communication sessions are being planned.




