Three Rangers—Samiksha Devi, Prajal Sharma, and Payal Sharma BA 3rd year—from the BA III Year participated in the state-level Rajya Puruskar Testing Camp for Rovers and Rangers. This event was organized by the Bharat Scouts and Guides at the Himachal Pradesh Headquarters, held at the State Training Centre in Rewalsar, District Mandi, HP, from September 5 to September 9, 2024. The participants underwent both written and practical assessments for the Rajya Puruskar test. The results will be announced by the organizing institution following the evaluation process, which will take place over the next few months.

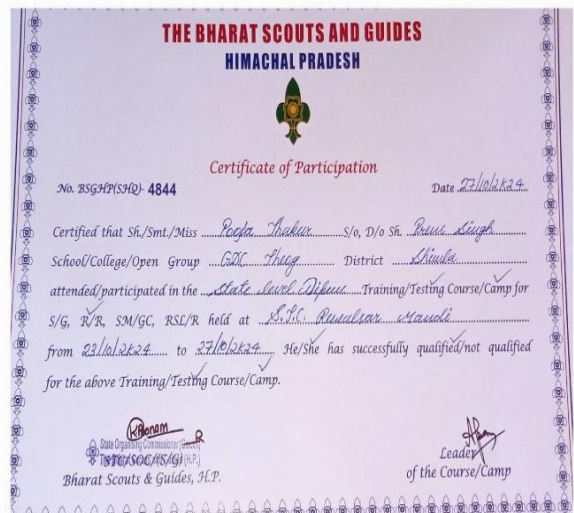
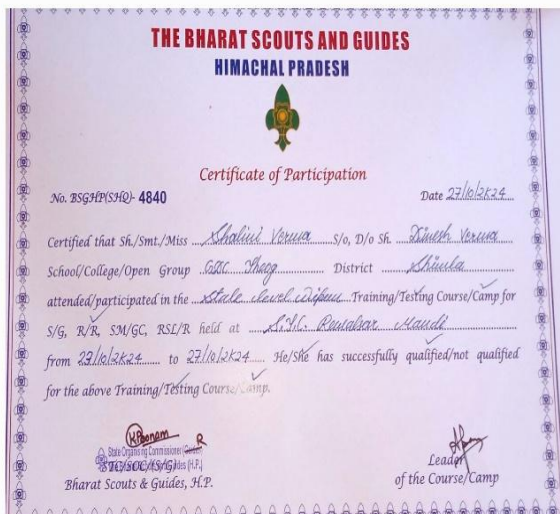

Objective:

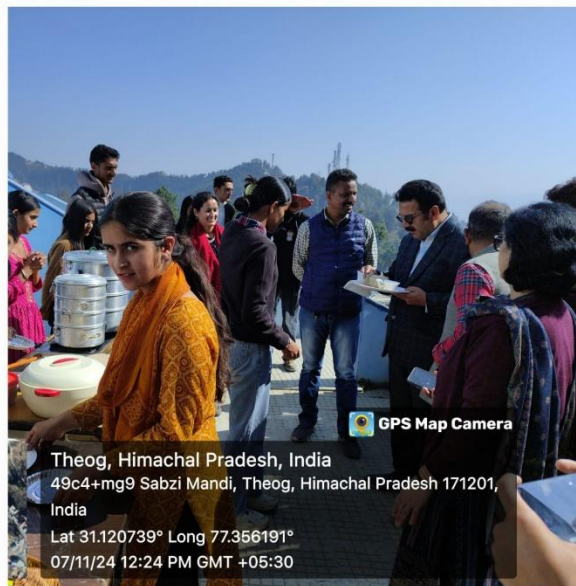


