

# Report on Training Program for Rovers and Rangers


Held in Nov 2025 at Sunni, District Shimla

**Institution: Government College, Theog, District Shimla (H.P.)**






- Navigation and team-building exercises


**3.3 Short-Term Courses & Training Modules** Short-term courses were made available to participating students on topics such as:
