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Report on Remedial Classes Session 2024-2025

Department of English

The Department of English organized remedial classes during the academic session 2024–2025 to provide academic support to students identified as slow learners or those requiring additional assistance. After reviewing internal assessments, class performance, and faculty observations, students in need of remedial instruction were notified and encouraged to attend the sessions.

The classes were conducted by Dr. Vinay Mohan Sharma, Dr. Raksha Kalta, Dr. Aditya Singh Dulta, and Ms. Chetna Negi. The focus of these sessions was to strengthen foundational language skills, clarify difficult textual concepts, and improve students' preparedness for internal and university examinations. Faculty members provided targeted guidance through simplified explanations, grammar reinforcement, and structured writing practice.

Attendance was recorded regularly, and the progress of participating students showed measurable improvement in comprehension, writing abilities, and overall academic confidence. The department notes that the remedial initiative fulfilled its intended objectives and recommends its continuation for future sessions to ensure academic inclusivity and enhanced student performance.
