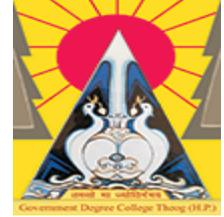

The students actively participated in a science-themed quiz competition, testing their knowledge across various scientific disciplines. This activity promoted critical thinking and collaborative learning among participants.

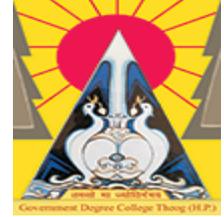
Lecture on Thermodynamics by Dr. M.S. Chauhan

Outcomes and Reflections

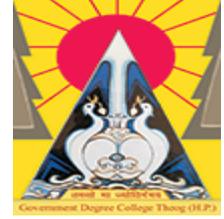
