



Report on Workshop on NEP 2020

Government College Theog, under the aegis of IQAC, organized a Workshop on “NEP 2020” on **13th May 2026** in the Conference Hall of the college at 10:30 AM onwards. The workshop was conducted with the objective of sensitizing and acquainting the teaching staff with the significant reforms and academic changes introduced under the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and to prepare the institution for its effective implementation in the upcoming academic sessions.

The programme was organized under the guidance and patronage of the Principal, Dr. Bhupinder Singh Thakur. Faculty members from all departments actively participated in the workshop. The event commenced with a formal welcome address by Prof. Pardeep Thakur, IQAC Coordinator, who welcomed the Principal, resource person, and faculty members. - Use of technology and digital platforms in teaching and evaluation.
- Integration of internship and community outreach programmes into the academic framework.

An interactive session was also held during which faculty members raised queries and shared their suggestions regarding the practical implementation of NEP 2020 in the college. The resource person addressed the concerns related to credit allocation, curriculum design, evaluation methods, and coordination among departments for multidisciplinary activities. The discussion proved highly productive and helped the participants gain a clearer understanding of their academic responsibilities under the new education policy.

The Principal, Dr. Bhupinder Singh Thakur, addressed the gathering and appreciated the efforts of IQAC in organizing such an important sensitization workshop.
