

## A Report on the Field Visit

The Botany Department and Eco Club of Government Degree College Theog jointly organized a field visit for B.Sc. students on 31<sup>st</sup> October 2025. Around 20 students from B.Sc. I, II, and III year (Medical) participated in this educational excursion. The students assembled on the college campus and proceeded towards a nearby forest area for the study of local biodiversity.
