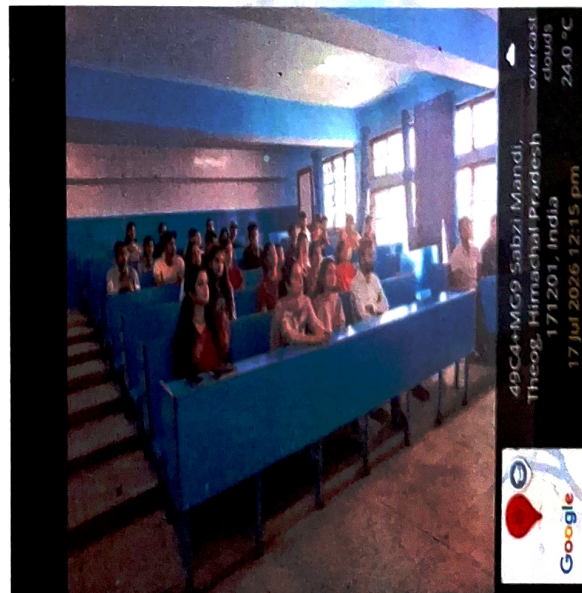
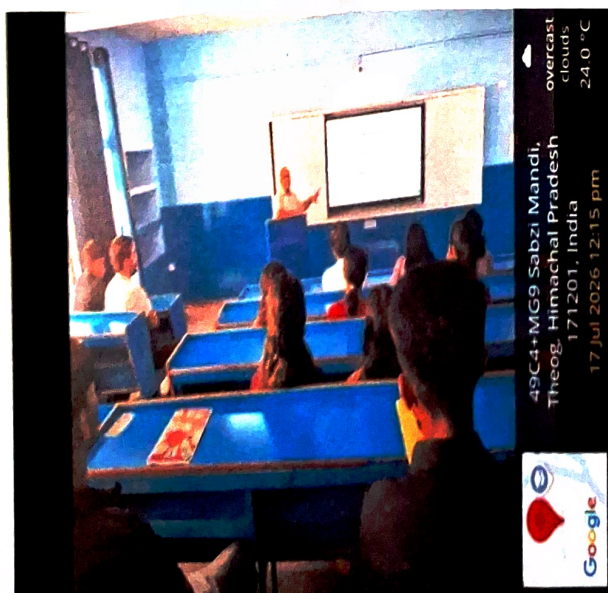
Report on Academic Counselling and Orientation Session for Science

Students Government Degree College Theog

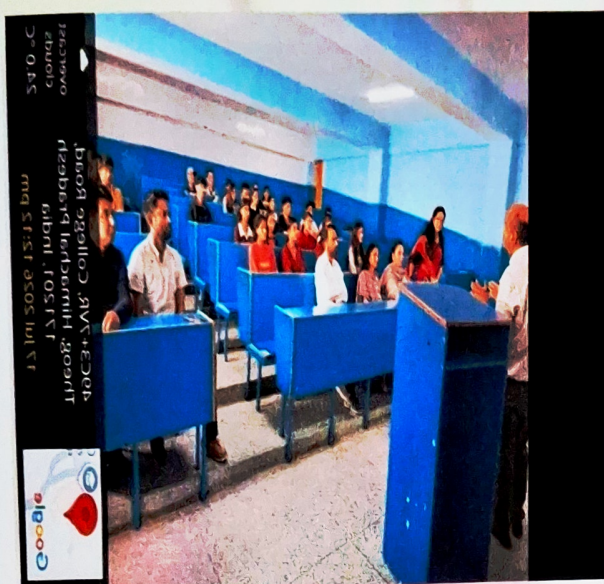
