Report on Plantation drive organized by Science Society

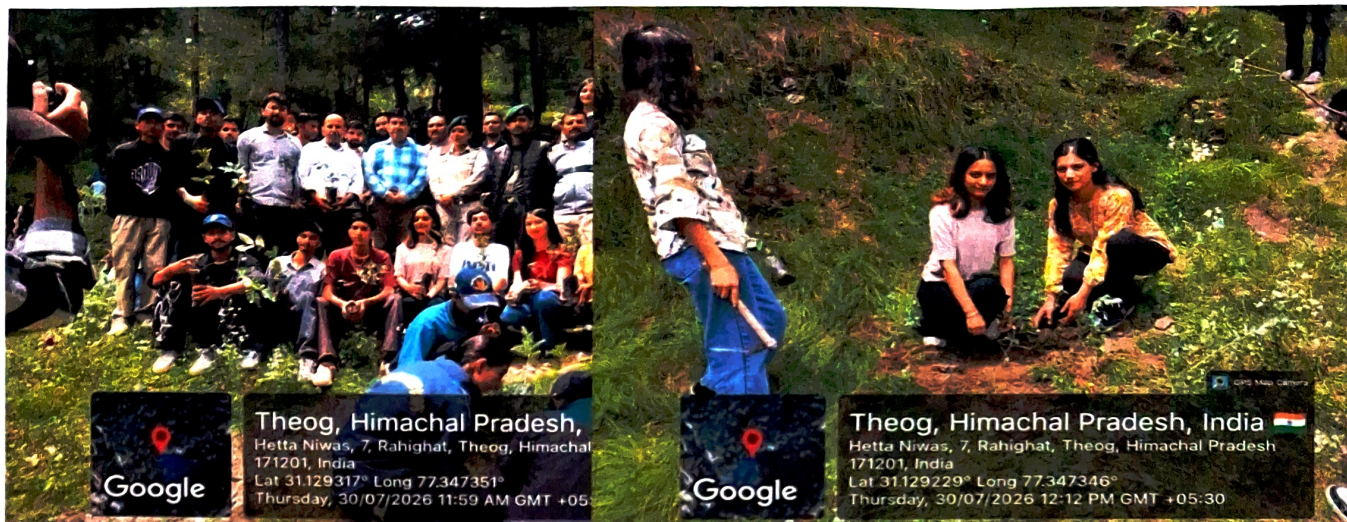
