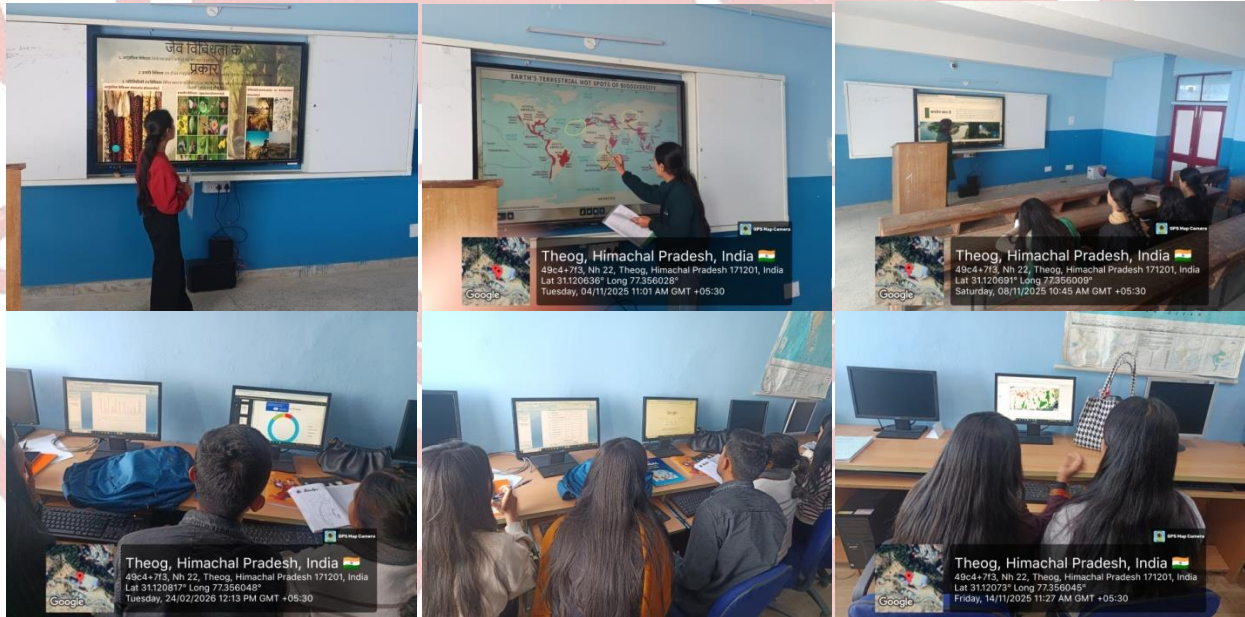


Report on Use of ICT in Geography Teaching
