Model Making – Participants designed models representing the structure and importance of the ozone layer.

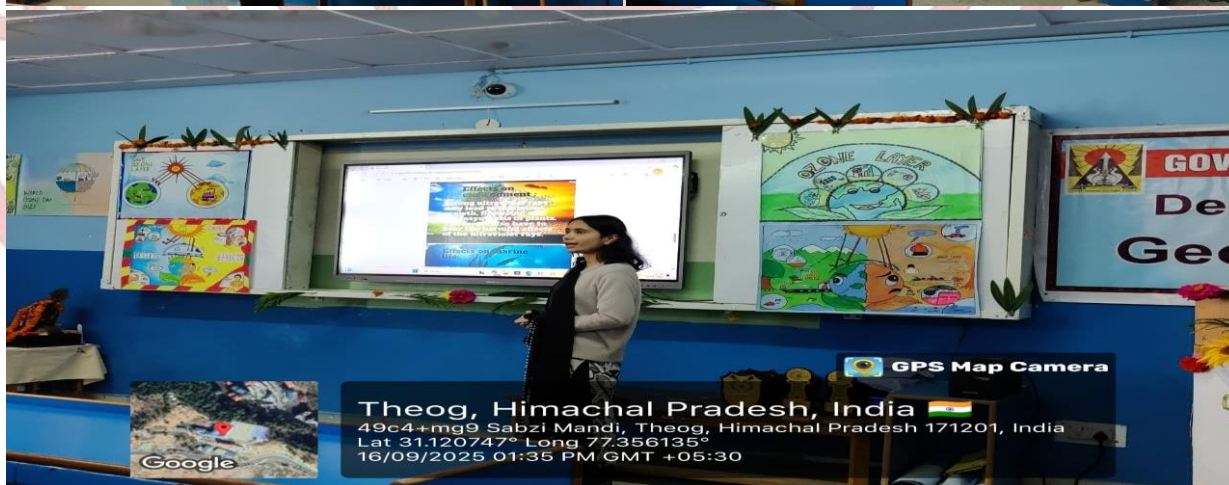
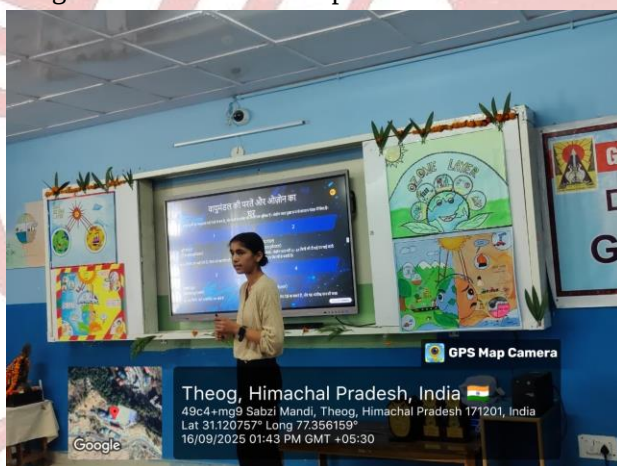


Skit Performance – Students presented skits focusing on the causes and effects of ozone layer depletion and the role of society in its conservation.
