

REPORT ON QUIZ COMPETITION

A Quiz Competition on the theme ***Sustainability and Development*** was organized for the students of **B.A. 3rd Year** by the Department of Geography on **27/11/2025**. The programme was conducted by Dr Rajesh Kumar, Assistant Professor, with the objective of enhancing students' awareness and understanding of sustainability issues at local, national, and global levels.
