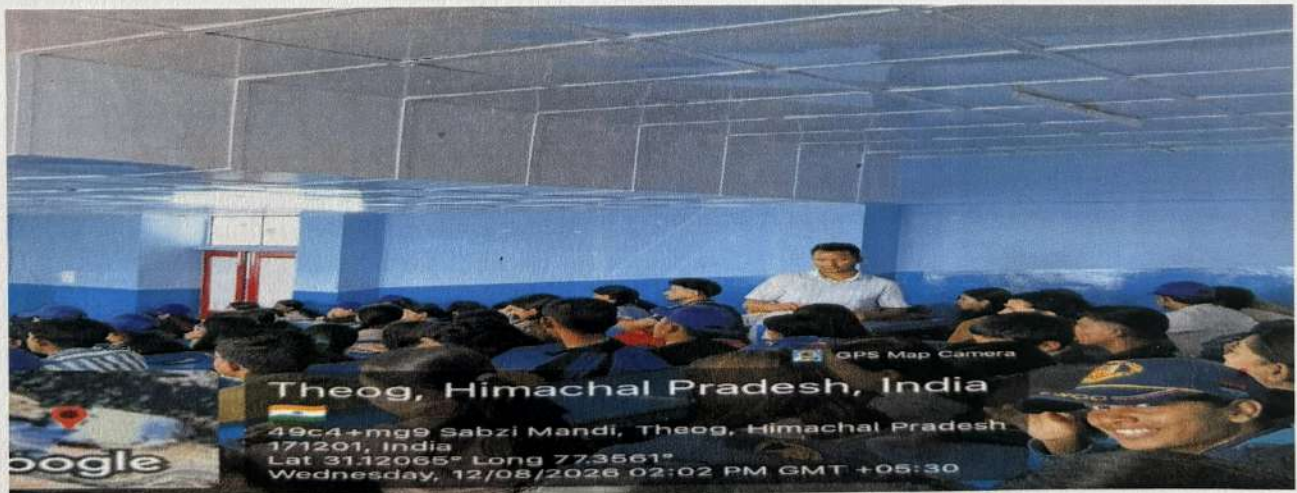
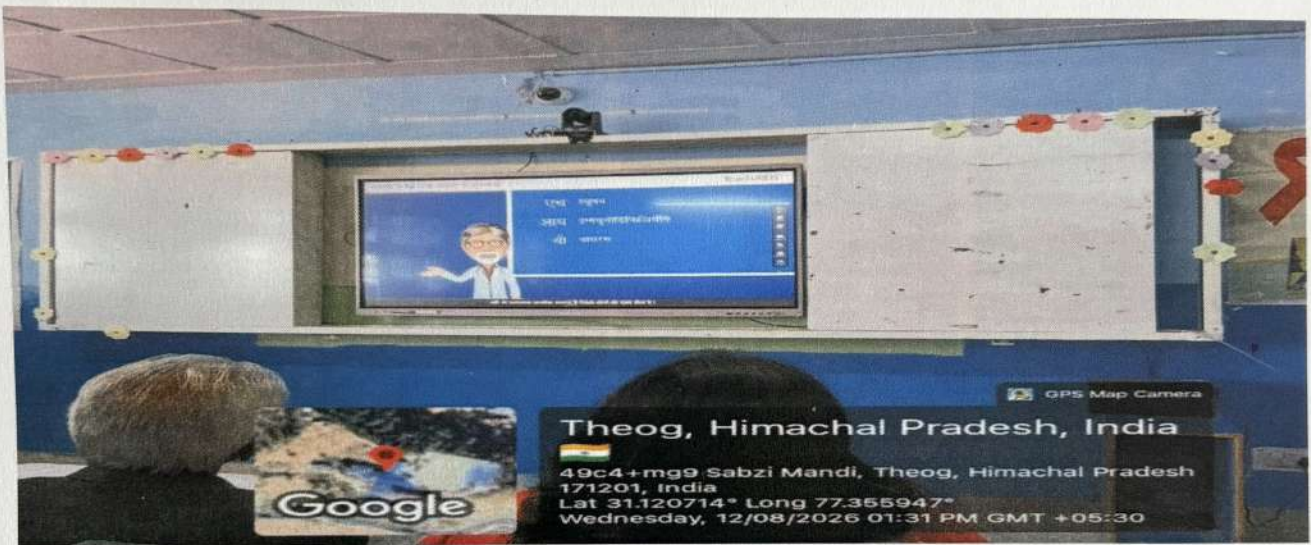
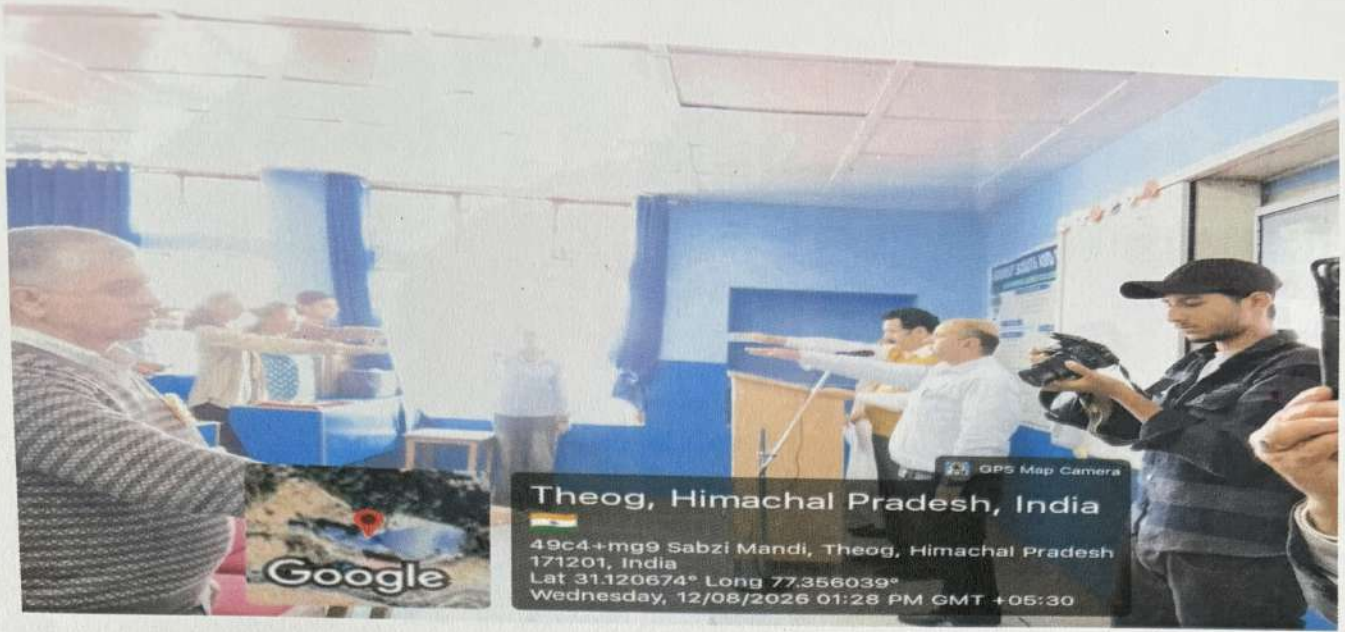
The programme commenced with an anti-drug oath administered by Dr. Bhupinder Thakur, Principal, Government College Theog. While administering the oath, the Principal urged students to remain committed to spreading awareness about HIV/AIDS, abstaining from substance abuse, and contributing towards the creation of a healthy, responsible, and drug-free society. He encouraged students to make informed and responsible life choices and motivated them to become ambassadors of positive change in their communities.

As part of the awareness campaign, an educational video on HIV/AIDS was screened to provide students with scientific information about HIV transmission, methods of prevention, the importance of early awareness, and the need to eliminate stigma and discrimination associated with the disease.

The programme also featured an awareness lecture on drug abuse and its legal implications delivered by Advocate Umesh, Bar Council, Theog. He sensitized students about the harmful effects of drug addiction on individuals and society and explained the legal provisions and penalties related to the use and trafficking of narcotic substances. He urged the youth to stay away from drugs and play an active role in promoting a drug-free environment.
