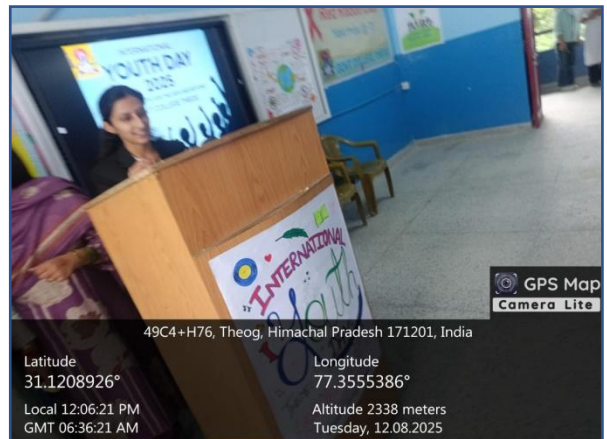
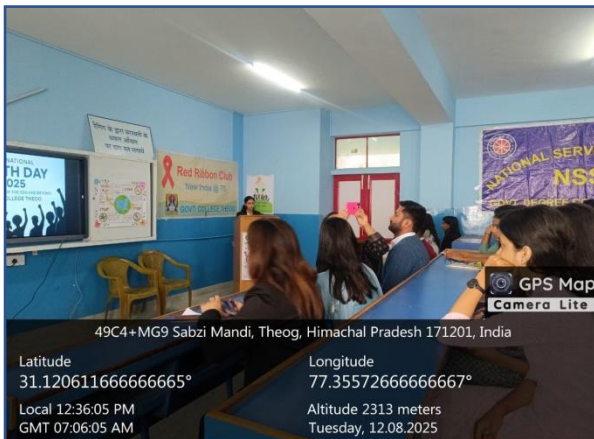
Post-Screening Discussion:

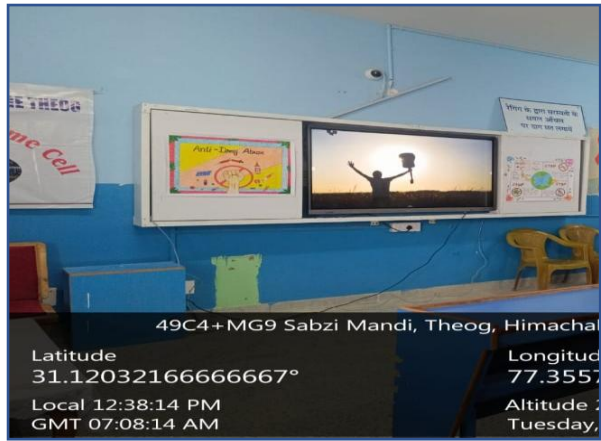
